NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Riverside has prepared its draft update of the HUD Annual Action Plan for program years 2019-2020. The publication of this notice is the beginning of the public review period required under Federal Regulation 21 CFR 91.105 (b)(2). The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has granted a waiver to the 30-day minimum public comment period in order to expedite the use of funds under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). The public review and written comment period will begin May 21, 2020, and run through May 25, 2020.

BACKGROUND


The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) approved the City of Riverside to adopt the 2019/2020 Annual Action Plan for use of federal entitlement funding from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Consolidated Plan provides an inventory of existing programs and activities, resources, demographics, unmet needs, and identifies strategies and resources such as, the Community Development Block Grant funds (CDBG), HOME, Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), needed to implement programs and activities to address the unmet needs. With the approval of the Consolidated Plan, it is the Annual Action Plan that incrementally addresses and implements identified programs and activities prepared and submitted to HUD for approval. The Annual Action Plan prepared for 2019/2020 implements the strategies and goals identified in the Consolidated Plan. The City is proposing to update this plan to allow for use of The CARES Act for grants to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus (CDBG-CV grants). CARES Act funding has been provided to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA).
