Dear Mr. Watson:

The California Office of Historic Preservation (OHP) must pass a minimum of ten percent of our yearly allocation of the federal Historic Preservation Fund to Certified Local Governments through our competitive grant program. It is my pleasure to inform you that through that process the OHP has selected the City of Riverside to receive a 2024-2026 Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of \$40,000 to develop a Women of Riverside Historic Context Statement.

In early October of 2024, you will receive a project agreement (contract) from OHP for your review and signature stipulating the project scope, budget, due dates for progress reports, and the deliverables. All expenses for work under this contract must be incurred within the grant period of October 1, 2024 and April 30, 2026.

This grant and its attendant contract are only valid and enforceable if the United States Government makes sufficient funds available to the State for the fiscal year 2024-2025 for the purpose of this program.
