3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the 2APSC under the terms and conditions specified in the 2APSC;

4. Authorize the City Manager or his designee(s) to participate in the IPP Renewal Project (RP) subscription process administered by the IPA for a project participation up to 5% or approximately 60 MW (assuming cost effectiveness in comparison to other similar resources);

5. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee to execute the Renewal Power Sales Contract (RPSC) and as applicable, the Renewal Excess Power Sales Agreement (REPSA) throughout the RP subscription process and upon the completion of IPP RP subscription process, report back to City Council and the Board of Public Utilities the final subscription result of the Renewal Project; and

6. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute any documents necessary to administer the 2APSC, the RPSC and the REPSA, collectively the IPP Renewal Agreements ("Renewal Agreements") that are consistent with the policies established by the City Council.
