PLANNING CASE P15-0947: Proposal by Andrea Urbas of Cortel, Inc, on behalf of Verizon Wireless, to consider a Conditional Use Permit for a 35 foot high wireless telecommunications facility, disguised as a streetlight pole, and related equipment within two separate segments of public right-of-ways, situated on the east and west sides of Chicago Avenue and south of Le Conte Avenue, adjacent to property zoned R-1-8500 – Single Family Residential in Ward 3.
