- Why Read?
 - It improves literacy and vocabulary
 - Provides critical thinking skills
 - gives children the tools to discover and interpret the world around them
 - Reading cultivates imagination
 - Reading improves social development

 - Register at home or at the library on our website or the Beanstack tracker app.
 - Using Beanstack, readers log their books.
 - Any books can be used.
 - Readers earn prizes as they go.
 - Super easy, self-paced!
