A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ALL NECESSARY APPLICATIONS, CONTRACTS, PAYMENT REQUESTS, AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING FOR AND SECURING FUNDS UNDER THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING GRANT PROGRAM RBC 32 (FY 2020/21) AND RBC 33 (FY 2021/22)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code section 40000 et seq., the Department of Resource Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle"), is to administer various Grant Programs ("grants") in furtherance of the State of California's ("State") efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program application procedures require an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("City") desires to establish a Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program in accordance with CalRecycle's Program and also desires to extend the City Manager's authority to include the authority to apply for and secure the available funds on behalf of the City available under CalRecycle's Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program, and carryout all other purposes in the application process administered by CalRecycle, and such authority shall be valid from the date of adoption of this Resolution up to and including June 30, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Council of the City of Riverside does hereby authorize application to CalRecycle for a Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program.

Section 2: The City Manager, or its designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute

1	on behalf of the City all necessary documents, including but not limited to applications, payment
2	requests, agreements and amendments thereto, necessary to secure grant funds and to implement the
3	approved grant project.
4	Section 3: The authority granted herein shall be valid until June 30, 2025.
