





## **PROJECT OVERVIEW**


### **PROJECT GOALS**

- Plant 600 trees: application documents indicate an estimated net GHG benefit of 868 MT CO2
- Construct asphalt concrete-paved multi-use path and natural surface trail in parallel
- Install solar lighting along the length of the project corridor
- Create unique access points with pedestrian and bicyclist amenities










### Physical:


- 500 Mailers distributed to residents within ¼ mile of the project area

- Project flyers distributed in AUSD student take-home packages





































### INTERDEPARTMENTAL MOU

#### MOU KEY TERMS

- The City of Riverside Parks Dept. will take the lead in monitoring this segment of the trail and responding to any 311 calls.
- Parks will retain a contractor to perform the maintenance responsibilities through the City's competitive procurement process.
- Parks and RPU will then pay a portion of these costs based on associated responsibilities.
- RPU ratepayer funds won't be used for any costs associated with the operation of the trail or liabilities arising from Trail operations.

- Finalize 100% Plans November 2021
- City Council Meeting December 2021
- Execute MOU between City Departments January 2022
- Bid/Construction Documents & Specifications January 2022
- Award Contractor Agreement February / March 2022
- Construction & Installation March 2022 December 2022
