BACKGROUND

- 1. Senate Bill 1087 requires water and sewer providers to adopt a policy that reserves water and sewer capacity for proposed developments that include housing units for lower-income households
- 2. California Department of Housing and Community Development also requires a City's Housing Element include this adopted policy

DISCUSSION

- Proposed resolution sets forth written policies and procedures giving low-income housing development projects priority for the provision of water and sewer services in conformance with SB 1087
- 2. If adopted, the policies and procedures would apply only to the provision of service to new low-income development
- 3. No impact on prioritization of water or sewer service in the event of an emergency
