BACKGROUND

1. Senate Bill 1087 requires water and sewer providers to adopt a policy that reserves water and sewer capacity for proposed developments that include housing units for lower-income households
2. California Department of Housing and Community Development also requires a City's Housing Element include this adopted policy

DISCUSSION

1. Proposed resolution sets forth written policies and procedures giving low-income housing development projects priority for the provision of water and sewer services in conformance with SB 1087
2. If adopted, the policies and procedures would apply only to the provision of service to new low-income development
3. No impact on prioritization of water or sewer service in the event of an emergency
