BACKGROUND

In June 2021, Mayor Patricia Lock Dawson created a Working Group co-chaired by Ward 1 Councilmember, Erin Edwards and Ward 7 Councilmember, Steven Hemenway to attract:

- 1. City Investment
- 2. Private Investment
- 3. Public Awareness

On February 1, 2022, City Council directed the group to identify a public outreach process and potential funding sources for opportunities for development along the Santa Ana River and strategies for implementation.

- 1. Homeless encampments
- 2. Fire hazards
- 3. Lack of awareness about the river or where to access it
- 4. Safety concerns
- 5. Lack of water in the river
- 6. Regulatory and jurisdictional challenges
- 7. Funding for maintenance of existing trail infrastructure
- 8. Lack of amenities


