ISSUE:

Receive a report on the Riverside Municipal Airport operations and activities for the period of July 2021 to April 2022.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Airport Commission receive a report on Riverside Municipal Airport operations and activities for the period of July 2021 to April 2022.

BACKGROUND:

The Airport Manager Operation and Activity Report is provided to inform the Airport Commission (Commission) about operations, City Council actions, events, meetings and other issues concerning the Riverside Municipal Airport (Airport).

DISCUSSION:

This update includes information about Airport operations, financials, activities, events, and investment in infrastructure.

Recent City Council and Committee Actions:

On January 4, 2022, City Council approved the Master Professional Consultant Services Agreement with Mead & Hunt, Inc. This Agreement will provide for an on-call consultant for services including airport project design, construction management and environmental studies. The term of the Agreement is five years with a contract amount not-to-exceed \$500,000.

On February 15, 2022, City Council approved a First Amendment for the Riverside Airport Café. This amendment expands the leasehold footprint by approximately 1,140 square feet and increases rent by \$250 per month. The total estimated rent over the term of the lease will be \$305,458.

Upcoming City Council and Committee Actions:

There are no items currently scheduled for action by City Council.

Other activities and events

The United States Congress recently passed the Bipartisan Infrastructure Bill. The Bill provides \$15 billion for airport related projects across the country. Staff has been notified that \$295,000 will be set aside for Riverside Municipal Airport. It is anticipated these funds will be formally offered to the Airport in May or June 2022. It is staff's intention to immediately invest these funds in much needed pavement improvements for the Airport.

The City executed a Supplemental Agreement with the Airport's on-call airport design consultant, Mead & Hunt, Inc. Mead & Hunt has been tasked to prepare design documents for a paving and minor asphalt repair project covering approximately 200,000 square feet of aircraft ramp. The project encompasses several hangar rows just west of the air traffic control tower and the aircraft ramp west of the terminal building. Construction costs will be determined following a formal construction bidding process and are estimated at \$400,000. All project costs will be paid through Airport revenues. The project is estimated to begin in the Fall of 2022.

Mead & Hunt, Inc., is also working on a project design for the rehabilitation of the Airport's primary east/west taxiway, Taxiway A. The project will be supported by federal grants and is

estimated to cost \$500,000. Construction will follow a formal bidding process and is anticipated to begin in the Fall of 2022.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT:

The **AIRPORT MANAGER OPERATION AND ACTIVITY REPORT** contributes to Strategic Priority No. 5 *High Performing Government* and Goal No. 5.3 – Enhance communication and collaboration with community members to improve transparency, build public trust, and encourage shared decision-making.
