

AIRPORT LEASING PROGRAM UPDATE

Airport Commission June 9, 2022

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BACKGROUND

- 1. The Riverside Municipal Airport (Airport) routinely solicits for and negotiates new leases and agreements in order to ensure new and continuous revenue sources for the Airport.
- 2. There are currently 160 existing leases:
 - 1. 17 Aircraft tie-downs
 - 2. 97 Hangars
 - 3. 24 Commercial office/hangar
 - 4. 22 Commercial Ground



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DISCUSSION

- Subject to City Council approval, the proposed leasing program update continues the authority for the Airport Manager to negotiate terms, incentives, maintenance responsibilities and other factors with prospective tenants.
- 2. All leases and agreements beyond a month-to-month period will continue to be approved by City Council.
- 3. The updated leasing program also clarifies the process for the City to provide written consent to subleases.



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AIRPORT LEASE RATES

- 1. A recent survey of 15 surrounding general aviation airports confirmed that the proposed lease rates are commensurate with regional airports for office space, hangars, aircraft tie-downs, and land.
- 2. The survey insight is in line with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations which require that airport rental rates be applied in a fair and equitable basis.



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PROPOSED UPDATES

Proposed Updates include:

- 1. Increase in hangar rental rates of approximately 8%.
- 2. Expansion of sub-letting restrictions.
- 3. Clarification of non-aviation businesses to include month-to-month agreements only.
- 4. Introduction of a one-year warranty for HVAC system.
- 5. Requirement for tenant to obtain Special Event Permit from City for applicable activities.
