BACKGROUND

- Riverside Municipal Code (RMC) Title 12 Airport and Aircraft Regulations provides governance to operations and activities at the Riverside Municipal Airport.
- 2. Chapter 12 of the RMC is regularly reviewed and updated to conform with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations and requirements.

PROPOSED UPDATES

Proposed modifications to RMC Title 12 include:

- 1. Add language for entities to host special events at the Airport.
- 2. Update language associated with Unmanned Aircraft Systems ("drones").
- 3. Update language for motor vehicle operations on the Airport to include parking restrictions, speed limits, and rental car delivery/ pickup.

PROPOSED UPDATES

Proposed modifications to RMC Title 12 include:

- 4. Update language associated with Airport perimeter gate access to include blocking open a gate and gate card access controls.
- 5. Establish requirements for fire extinguishers in aircraft hangars in compliance with local fire regulations.
- 6. Restrict use of aircraft wash racks for aircraft only.
- 7. Establish rules for departing aircraft to reduce noise impact on surrounding community.
