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NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION AREAS

- Established in 1980 with initial adoption of Title 20
- Provided some level of protection to non-designated districts
- Criteria determined subjective and not conveying significance by Land Use
 Committee and City Council
- Program eliminated in 2010 by City Council No new NCAs can be created
- Existing NCAs subject to Certificate of Appropriateness and Title 20 and eligible for Mills Act and Historic Preservation Fund
 - Old Magnolia Avenue NCA
 - Rockledge NCA
 - St. Andrews Terraces NCA
 - Wood Streets NCA

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
