ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 10.08 OF THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 10.08.050 REGARDING SUSPENSION OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Chapter 10.08.050 is hereby added to the Riverside Municipal Code as follows:

"Section 10.08.050 Suspension of Parking Restrictions.

Notwithstanding the relative sections of this Code, the City Traffic Engineer or their designee may suspend any of the parking regulations or restrictions set forth in said sections upon the following conditions:

- (a) A written application for the suspension of all or any such parking regulations shall be filed with the Public Works Department.
- (b) The Public Works Department shall refer such application to the City Traffic Engineer or their designee.
- (c) The City Traffic Engineer or their designee shall find that the requested suspension of all or any such parking regulations or restrictions is in the public interest and is in connection with a civic celebration, community event, or otherwise is for the benefit of the citizens of the City and may authorize the suspension of the enforcement of the provisions of any said sections for such periods of time not exceeding six months and, upon such conditions as the City Traffic Engineer or their designee may deem necessary, for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare."
- Section 2: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony, hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2), 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations,

1	Title 14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result	in a direct or	reasonably foreseeable indirect	
2	physical change.			
3	Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify	y to the adopti	on of this ordinance and cause	
4	publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the			
5	Charter of the City of Riverside. This ordinance	shall become e	ffective on the 30th day after the
