

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, CONFIRMING THE DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT FOR
4 THE LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 88-1 (SYCAMORE
5 HIGHLANDS) AND LEVYING ASSESSMENTS ON ALL ASSESSABLE
6 LOTS AND PARCELS OF LAND THEREIN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-
7 2023.

8 WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022, the City Council (the “City Council”) of the City of
9 Riverside (the “City”) adopted Resolution No. 23859, a Resolution of Intention pursuant to
10 section 22624 of the Streets and Highways Code, which, among other things, scheduled a
11 hearing for July 5, 2022, at 3:00 p.m., on the proposed levy and collection of assessments on all
12 lots and parcels of assessable land in the Landscape Maintenance District No. 88-1 (Sycamore
13 Highlands, formerly known as Lusk Highlander or Highlander) (the “District”) of the City of
14 Riverside for the fiscal year 2022-2023 for the maintenance and servicing of landscaping and
15 park and recreational improvements, at the City Council Chambers of the City of Riverside, 3900
16 Main Street, Riverside, California; and

17 WHEREAS, notice of said hearing was duly published as required by said resolution,
18 sections 54954.6 of the Government Code, and sections 22556 and 22626 of the Streets and
19 Highways Code; and

20 WHEREAS, at the time and place of said hearing as set forth in said resolution, the City
21 Council held the hearing and afforded all interested persons an opportunity to hear and be heard,
22 and considered all oral statements and all written protests or communications made or filed by
23 any interested persons; and

24 WHEREAS, the City Council may proceed, pursuant to section 22631 of the Streets and
25 Highways Code, to adopt a resolution confirming the diagram and assessment, either as
26 originally proposed, or as changed by it, and the adoption of such a resolution shall constitute the
27 levy of an assessment on all assessable lots and parcels of land within the District for fiscal year
28 2022-2023.

1 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the City
2 Council of the City of Riverside, as follows:

3 Section 1. Findings. The City Council finds:

4 (a) The preceding recitals are correct;
5 (b) Compliance has been had with all of the applicable requirements of the
6 Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, being Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of
7 Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code and with Article XIII D section 4(e) of the
8 California Constitution;

9 (c) The City Council may proceed to adopt a resolution confirming the
10 diagram and assessment either as originally proposed or as changed by it;

11 (d) The assessments proposed to be levied on the assessable lots and parcels
12 of land in the District for the maintenance and servicing of landscaping during the fiscal year
13 2022-2023 contained in the report of Webb Municipal Finance, LLC, on file with the City Clerk
14 (the "Report") are based on the assessment formula established in the report and on the benefit
15 derived by such lots and parcels from the availability of such landscaping, and are not based
16 upon the ownership or value of such lots or parcels.

17 Section 2. Improvements. The improvements authorized for the District are:

18 (a) The installation and planting of landscaping, including trees, shrubs, grass,
19 and other ornamental vegetation;

20 (b) The installation of park and recreation improvements, including, but not
21 limited to, all of the following:

22 (i) Land preparation, such as grading, leveling, cutting and filling,
23 sod, landscaping, irrigation systems, sidewalks, and drainage; and

24 (ii) Lights, playground equipment, play courts, and public restrooms;

25 (c) The maintenance or servicing, or both, of the aforementioned
26 improvements;

27 (d) The acquisition of land for park, recreational, or open-space purposes.

28 Section 3. Confirmation of Report. The Report and the assessment diagram and

1 assessment of the estimated cost of the maintenance and servicing of the landscape
2 improvements for fiscal year 2022-2023 contained in the Report are confirmed.

3 Section 3. Levy of Assessment. Pursuant to section 22631 of the Streets and
4 Highways Code, the adoption of this resolution constitutes the levy of the assessment for the
5 maintenance and servicing of landscaping improvements within the District for fiscal year 2022-
6 2023, as contained in the Report, and such assessment is levied. The Chief Financial Officer is
7 directed to file or cause to be filed a certified copy of this resolution together with the diagram
8 and assessment contained in the Report with the County Auditor of the County of Riverside,
9 who, pursuant to section 22645 of the Streets and Highways Code, shall enter on the County
10 assessment (Fund 68-2734) roll opposite each lot or parcel of land the amount assessed
11 thereupon, as contained in said assessment.
