Analysis of local data shows that while black or African American people represent approximately 20% of persons experiencing homelessness on a daily basis, black or African American represent approximately 26% of individuals who become homeless for the first time each year. The increasing rate in which Black or African American people experiencing homelessness for the first time is 28%, while the increasing rate in which all individuals experiencing homelessness for the first time is only 17%.	Reduce the number of black or African American individuals who become homeless for the first time annually by 10%, exceeding our overall 5% reduction in the number of persons experiencing homeless for the first time annually.

Decrease the percentage of people who are experiencing substance abuse disorders who return to homelessness after exiting homelessness to permanent housing by 3%, which will also decrease our overall 5% goal.
