## **Recent City Council and Committee Actions:**

On July 19, 2022, City Council approved an update for the Airport Leasing Program. The Program establishes rates and charges for leased property on the Airport.

## Upcoming City Council and Committee Actions:

There are no items currently scheduled for action by City Council.

### Other activities and events

#### Taxiway A Rehabilitation Project

Mead & Hunt, Inc., is finalizing work on the design for the rehabilitation of the Airport's primary east/west taxiway, Taxiway A. The rehabilitation project will be supported by federal grants at an estimated cost of \$500,000. Construction will follow a formal bidding process and is anticipated to begin in Fall of 2022.

#### Aircraft Ramp Rehabilitation Project

Mead & Hunt, Inc., is finalizing the design for the rehabilitation of approximately 200,000 square feet of aircraft ramp pavement. The project will provide minor asphalt repair and sealing of pavement to improve the safety for aircraft operations. Project costs are estimated at \$400,000 and will be paid for from Airport revenue. The project is anticipated to begin in Fall of 2022.

### **STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT:**

The Airport Manager's Operation and Activity Report contributes to Strategic Priority No. 5 *High Performing Government* and Goal No. 5.3 – Enhance communication and collaboration with community members to improve transparency, build public trust, and encourage shared decision-making.

1. **Community Trust** - The Airport fosters community trust by regularly reviewing federal guidelines and regulations to ensure operational safety.
