RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO AMEND THE BOUNDARIES AND ASSESSMENT AMOUNTS OF, AND TO LEVY AN ANNUAL ASSESSMENT THE ARLINGTON IN. **BUSINESS** IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023, GENERALLY DESCRIBING THE IMPROVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN, AND FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ON THE LEVY OF THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 36534 OF THE CALIFORNIA STREET AND HIGHWAYS CODE.

WHEREAS the Arlington Business Improvement District in the Arlington area of the City of Riverside (the "District") was established by Ordinance No. 6626 for: (a) general business promotions; (b) business activities; (c) promotion of events; (d) advertising to promote area businesses; (e) landscaping; (f) clean-up activities; and (g) physical improvements; and

WHEREAS the District is located in the Arlington business area of the City of Riverside, and is described as generally between Arlington Avenue on the north, along Van Buren to Lincoln on the south, and a portion along Magnolia Avenue from Tyler Street on the west, to Jackson Street on the east and

WHEREAS the above-mentioned functions of the Arlington BID are funded by the assessments collected from the businesses within the District; and

WHEREAS each business within the District currently pays an amount equal to ninety percent (90%) of the City of Riverside business tax fee, not to exceed \$400.00 per business; and

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Riverside has received the annual report of the Arlington Business Partnership ("Report"), acting as the advisory board of the District for the fiscal year of 2022-2023 which has proposed modifications to the boundaries of and increased assessment amounts within the District to adequately fund the costs to perform the listed functions of the District; and

WHEREAS the report of the Arlington Business Partnership, as submitted to the City Council on August 16, 2022, more fully details the improvements and activities which shall be provided, as well as the proposed assessments to be levied, for the fiscal year beginning November 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS the Report is on file with the City Clerk and is available for review by the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, pursuant to Section 36534 of the California Streets & Highways Code, as follows:

Section 1: It is the intention of the City Council to levy and collect an assessment within the District for the fiscal year beginning November 1, 2022, at a rate of one hundred percent (100%) of the annual City Business Tax charge assessed per business, without a set maximum amount.

Section 2: It is the intention of the City Council to amend the boundaries of the Arlington Business Improvement District, which will be described as generally between Arlington Avenue on the north, along Van Buren to Lincoln on the south, and La Sierra on the west to Sherman Drive on the east; said area is more fully shown on the plat of the area on file with the Office of the City Clerk; and

Section 3: The Report of the Arlington Business Partnership more fully details the improvements and activities which include, but are not limited to: (a) general business promotions; (b) business activities; (c) promotion of events; (d) advertising to promote area businesses; (e) landscaping; (f) clean-up activities; and (g) physical improvements, as well as details of the proposed assessments to be levied for the fiscal year beginning November 1, 2022. The Report is on file with the City Clerk.

Section 4: NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council will hold an in-person and/or virtual public hearing on the levy of the proposed assessment for the fiscal year of 2022-2023, at 3:00 p.m. on September 20, 2022, at the regular meeting of the City council to be held at the regular place of meeting at said time in the Art Pick Council Chamber at the Riverside City Hall at 3900 Main Street in the City of Riverside, California.

Any protests or objections to the proposed levy of assessment may be made orally or in writing by any interested person. However, the content, form, and manner of such protests or objections shall comply with Section 36524 and 36525 of the California Streets and Highways Code.

7	public hearing at the Art Pick Council Chamber at 3900 Main Street, Riverside, CA.			
8	Section 5: The City Clerk shall give notice of the public hearing by causing the Resolution of			
9	Intention to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not less than seven			
10	days before the public hearing. Further, the City shall provide notice of the public hearing to each			
11	holder of a business license tax certificate within the designated Arlington Business Improvement			
12	District by mail, postage prepaid.
