WHO IS WELCOME

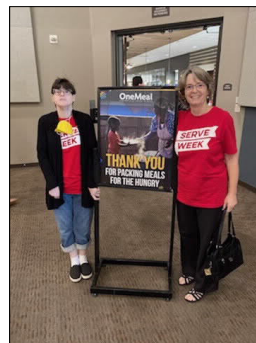
We welcome adults with various disabilities and their parents, caregivers, friends, and group homes.
