

BID RPU-7932 – AGREEMENT WITH KANA SUBSURFACE ENGINEERING, INC FOR LOCATING SUBSURFACE FACILITIES

BACKGROUND

- 1. Underground facility locating is not only vital to maintain the safety and reliability of underground utility systems but most importantly is required by California Government Code Section 4216.
- 2. Underground utilities planning to excavate are required by law to notify the California One Call 811 system, which informs all potentially affected utilities.
- 3. The City of Riverside averages 1,000 electric, 1,300 water, and 100 sewer locates per month.

DISCUSSION

1. Request for Bid No.RPU-7932 was posted on the City's Online Bid System (Planet Bids) on July 27, 2022, and closed August 9, 2022. Two (2) vendors submitted bids. KANA Subsurface Engineering, Inc., of Riverside, California was deemed the lowest bidder. The bids are summarized in the table below:

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Award Bid No. RPU-7932 for Locating Subsurface Facilities for City of Riverside Underground Utilities to Kana Subsurface Engineering, Inc. of Riverside, California in the annual amount of \$1,021,700;
- 2. Approve the Professional Services Agreement for Locating Subsurface Facilities for City of Riverside Underground Utilities with KANA Subsurface Engineering, Inc., of Riverside, California, for a three-year term ending October 4, 2025, with two optional one-year term extensions, in an annual amount of \$1,021,700; and
- 3. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Professional Services Agreement, including making minor and non-substantive changes, and with the option to extend for two additional one-year terms.
