#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the Community Police Review Commission:

- 1. Review, provide input, and approve by-law revisions recommended by the 2022 By-Law Review Ad Hoc Committee; and
- 2. Establish a 2022 Ad Hoc Committee to review Community Police Review Commission Policy and Procedure Manual.

#### BACKGROUND:

On April 27, 2022, the Community Police Review Commission (CPRC) 2022 By-Law Review Ad Hoc Committee was created by Chair Teichert. Chair Teichert appointed Commissioner Humphrey as Chair and Commissioner Hawkins as Vice Chair to serve on the committee.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The CPRC 2022 By-Law Review Ad Hoc Committee recommends the following revisions to the CPRC By-Laws:

- Article I Definitions; Section1, Items E, G, and H
- Article V Commission Officers; Section 2
- Article VI Authority, Powers, Duties; Section 1, Items C, I, and M
- Article VII Meetings; Sections 1, 3, 4, 6, 14, and 16
- Article VIII Investigations and Hearings; Sections 1, 3, and 4
