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BACKGROUND

1. On May 13, 1901, Elizabeth Paine granted an indenture to the Riverside Water Company.
2. On May 22, 1901, the City as successor-in-interest to the Riverside Water Company was granted access to the property to extract water by means of artesian wells.
3. On May 23, 1961, the Paine Hot Well Agreement allowed for the construction of up to six (6) wells on the property.

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DISCUSSION

1. QR Waterman DC, LLC (QR) is the owner of the 25.25-acre property located on the southwest corner of Waterman Avenue and Dumas Street.
2. QR proposes permanent easement and temporary construction easement for future potable well.
3. RPU concurs easement areas are sufficient and permanent easement is beneficial to Utility.
