BACKGROUND

- RTRP is a Southern California Edison project approved by the CPUC for the design, construction, and operation of a high voltage transmission line to supply reliable electric service to the City Riverside through a new second connection to the state bulk electric grid system
- May 10, 2022 – City Council authorized CM Hemenway to work with city staff and a consultant for an assessment/study of potential RTRP project modifications
- Following three RFP processes, a contract was executed with California Strategies, LLC on September 15, 2022
