## Professional Group Backs Cologne

Formation of a "committee from the professions" supporting the candidacy of Gordon Cologne, Republican nominee for the state assembly, was announced Wednesday by Joseph S. Marriott, the candidate's Riverside campaign chairman.

The committee, headed by Dr. John C. Ivanoff and including attorneys, doctors, dentists and public accountants, issued the following statement:
