4	The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:												
5	Section 1: Table 19.150.020.B of the Riverside Municipal Code entitled "Incidental Uses												
6	Table" is amended as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.												
7	Section 2: Section 19.550.025 of the Riverside Municipal Code entitled "Monitored												
8	Electrified Security Fence System" is added as shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated												
9	herein.												
10	Section 3: Section 19.910.140 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as												
11	follows:												
12	"Section 19.910.140 "M" Definitions.												
13	Major street frontage. See "frontage, major street."												
14													
15	Monitored Electrified Security Fence System means a perimeter alarm system that transmits a												
16	signal intended to alert the business utilizing the system and/or an alarm monitoring service in response												
17	to an intrusion or burglary with an assembly of battery powered equipment, including but not limited												
18	to:												
19	1. A monitored alarm device and energizer which is intended to periodically deliver pulses to a												
20	security fence;												
21	2. A battery charging device used exclusively to charge the system's battery; and												
22	3. Other integrated components.												
23	"												
24	Section 4: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and information												
25	contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony, hereby finds that												
26	this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) (General												
27	Rule), as it can be seen with certainty that approval of the project will not have an effect on the												
28	environment.

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EXHIBIT "B"

Chapter 19.550.025 MONITORED ELECTRIFIED SECURITY FENCE SYSTEM

19.550.025 Monitored Electrified Security Fence System

The construction and use of a Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall be allowed as provided in this Section, subject to the following requirements:

- A. Unless otherwise specified herein, Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall be constructed and operated in conformance with the specifications set forth in International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) Standard No. 60335-2-76 current edition.
- B. The energizer for Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems must be driven by a commercial storage battery, not to exceed 12 volts DC, that is charged primarily by a solar panel.
- C. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall be installed 4-8 inches behind a minimum 5-foot-high non-electrified perimeter fence/wall.
- D. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall have a height of 10 feet, or 2 feet higher than the perimeter barrier, whichever is lower.
- E. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems adjacent to residential or residentially zoned properties shall be located behind a minimum 6-foot tall block wall.
- F. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall be clearly identified with warning signs that read: "Warning-Electric Fence" at intervals of not more than 30 linear feet.
- G. Permitted Locations.
 - 1. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems are prohibited in all Residential, Mixed-Use, and Public Facilities zoning districts.
 - 2. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall be permitted in Industrial Zones as identified in Table 19.150.020.B Incidental Use Table.
 - 3. Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall be permitted in Commercial and Other Zones (except in PF Public Facilities zone) as identified in Table 19.150.020.B Incidental Use Table for specific uses in 19.150.020.A Permitted Uses Table, including the following:
 - Ambulance company with vehicle storage
 - Cemeteries, Mortuaries & Ancillary Uses
 - Crematoriums
 - Commercial storage facilities (mini-warehouse)
 - Equipment sales and rental
 - Heliport or Helistop
 - Laundry commercial

- Outdoor storage yard
- Parking lot or parking structure
- Golf courses and driving ranges
- Vehicle parts and accessories
- Outdoor storage
- Vehicle rental
- Wireless telecommunication facilities
- 4. Installation of Electrified Security Fence Systems are prohibited in properties adjacent to a park.
- H. Specific Plan Requirements.
 - 1. In any Specific Plan district where specified uses, including legal nonconforming uses, are permitted by the current zoning designation, including aircraft and helicraft related industries, ambulance companies, building materials supply, commercial storage facilities, equipment sales and rental, laundry commercial, lumber yard and building materials, wholesale, sales of manufactured dwellings, outdoor storage yard, parking lot or parking structure, golf courses and driving ranges, recycling centers, taxi company with vehicle storage, truck terminals, vehicle impound and tow yards, vehicle parts and accessory, outdoor storage, vehicle repair, vehicle rentals, vehicle wholesale business, warehousing & distribution facilities and wireless telecommunication facilities, a Conditional Use Permit shall be required.
 - Uses not listed above are prohibited unless the Community & Economic Development Department Director, or his/her designee, pursuant to <u>Chapter</u> <u>19.060</u> (Interpretation of Code), determines that the use is similar and no more detrimental than a listed use.
- I. Required Permitting.
 - 1. All Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall require a building permit.
 - 2. All Monitored Electrified Security Fence Systems shall require an Alarm User's Permit pursuant to Chapter 5.58.
- J. It shall be unlawful for any person to install, maintain or operate a Monitored Electrified Security Fence System in violation of this Section.
