ISSUE:

Receive and discuss a Museum presentation created for Board Member Community Outreach purposes.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Museum of Riverside Board receive and discuss a Museum presentation created for Board Member Community Outreach purposes.

BACKGROUND:

Museum of Riverside Board Members are appointed by Council members and the Mayor to represent all wards of the City. They serve as a conduit between City Council—the Museum’s governing body—and community members.

DISCUSSION:

The main Museum remains closed, but the recent restart of the renovation and expansion project will bring renewed public interest in the Museum’s path forward as we move toward and through the construction phase. During this period, it will be of increasing importance that the community understands who and what the Museum of Riverside is and plans to become. Board Members have the opportunity to amplify the communication efforts of staff by themselves providing presentations introducing the Museum to community groups to which Board Members may belong.
