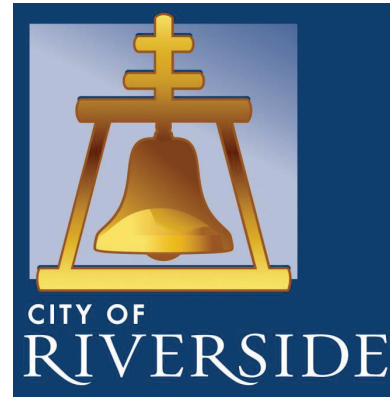
Who Are We?

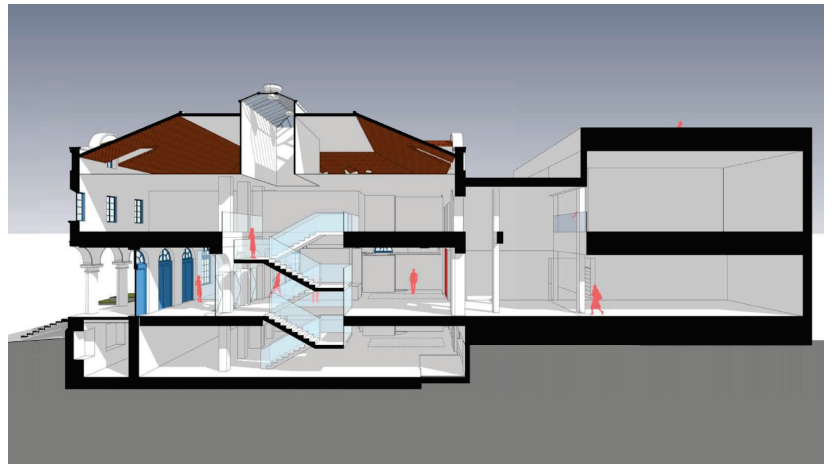
Main Museum Update

- Riverside City Council approved our project moving forward as of October 2022
- Steps include:
 - Completing architectural design
 - Community engagement
 - Construction bid and approval
 - Construction period
 - Installation of exhibitions
 - Grand reopening



Main Museum Update

- More active changing exhibition program after reopening
- Nature Lab to be larger
- Features not present before: loading dock, freight elevator, environmental controls to museum standards



Heritage House

- Since September 2017, our only site open to the public
- Few original furnishings – house is an imagining of an 1890s grower’s home
- Two temporary exhibitions annually
- Diligently maintained



Heritage House

- The operation of Heritage House depends on volunteers to guide tours, host events, and help maintain gardens
- Guided tours offered Fridays-Sundays; closed July and August



Harada House

- A National Historic Landmark, a State Historical Landmark, and a local historic landmark
- A civil rights site unique to Riverside

Harada House

- Harada House was the subject of a civil rights court case in 1916-1918.
- The Harada case was the first test in the U. S. of the constitutionality of exclusionary, racist property and immigration laws.
- The case was heard in the Riverside County Courthouse.

Harada House

- Campaign to fund the project exceeded its goal.
- Continuing to fundraise for endowment.
- Architects currently at work designing how the rehabilitation will occur, from the foundation up.





Harada House Interpretive Center

- Interpretive Center project, next door to Harada House, is under way concurrently.
- Plan is to demolish existing structure and reconstruct it to resemble its 1930s appearance.
- A complex, multi-year project is anticipated.



Programming Update

- Our staff actively present the Museum's own programs as well as participating in others' festivals and events.
- Soon to debut: Nature Lab On-the-Go.

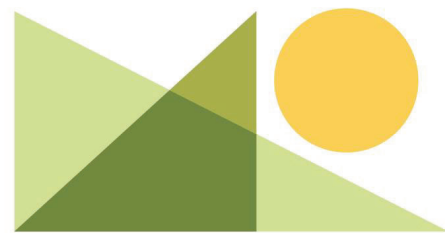
