


BACKGROUND

- 1. On July 19, 2022, the City Council reinstated the prior parking rates and hours program for the downtown, and directed staff to develop new rates following additional community engagement
- 2. On September 6, 2022, the City Council received the proposed community engagement plan for the amended parking rates and hours schedule



DISCUSSION

- City has deployed a project webpage including a "Balancing Act" simulation
- 2. Over 780 submissions to the simulation have been received
- 3. Residents have opted to increase spending on deferred maintenance

lan 2023	Deploy a citywide quick-format survey to receive input on major points of interest for the parking rates and hours schedule.
lan 2023	Host second community meeting to share back how feedback has impacted the draft rates & hours schedule, share draft schedule. Workshop and refine the parking program.
eb 2023	Present recommended parking rates and hours schedule to the Land Use, Sustainability and Resilience Committee
March 2023	Present final recommended parking rates and hours schedule to the City Council for consideration of adoption.
