

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE LOCAL
4 ROADWAY SAFETY PLAN.

5 WHEREAS, on October 10, 2019, the Public Works Department submitted an application to
6 the State Department of Transportation (“Caltrans”) for funding to establish a Local Roadway Safety
7 Plan (“LRSP”); and

8 WHEREAS, on December 4, 2019, Caltrans accepted the application; and

9 WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, the City Council awarded a Professional Services Agreement
10 to Kimley Horn & Associates Inc. to complete a LRSP in the amount of Ninety-Nine Thousand Five
11 Hundred Eight Dollars and Twenty-Three Cents (\$99,508.23); and

12 WHEREAS, having a draft LRSP document was a prerequisite for applying for the Cycle XI
13 Highway Safety Improvement Program (“HSIP”) grant funds; and

14 WHEREAS, on September 6, 2022, the City Council authorized the submittal of a Cycle XI
15 HSIP grant in the amount up to Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00); and

16 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department submitted an application for Cycle XI HSIP grant
17 funds and US Department of Transportation Safe Street and Roads for All (“SS4A”) grant funds, both
18 for a total project cost of Nine Million Eighteen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (9,018,200.00); and

19 WHEREAS, the LRSP will build on the recently adopted Riverside PACT (Pedestrian Target
20 Safeguarding Plan, Active Transportation Master Plan, Complete Streets Ordinance, and Trails Master
21 Plan Update) which included a comprehensive analysis of pedestrian and bicycle involved collisions
22 throughout the City; and

23 WHEREAS, the LRSP allows the City to be more competitive in applying for present and
24 future roadway safety grants; and

25 WHEREAS, the LRSP was reviewed by the Transportation Committee on November 2, 2022
26 and recommended that the City Council adopt the LRSP.

27 WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and
28 information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony,

1 hereby finds that this resolution is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Sections 15004,(b)(2), 15061(b)(3),
2 and/or 15262 of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3,
3 because at this early level of analysis it is not possible to accurately analyze environmental impacts;
4 the City is not committing to a definite course of action; it can be seen that it will not result in a direct
5 or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment nor have a significant impact
6 on the environment and it is not a project as defined in Section 15378.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
8 California, as follows:

9 Section 1. Based on the above recitals and the information presented in the staff report,
10 the City Council hereby adopts the Local Roadway Safety Plan as attached to the staff report.

11 Section 2: A copy of the Local Roadway Safety Plan shall be kept on file with the Public
12 Works Department.
