

BACKGROUND

- On October 28, 2021, HRC members provided feedback for commissioners to submit allocation proposals for the remaining \$5,000 in HRC funding.
- 2. Commissioner Ayra proposed that \$3,000 of existing funding be allocated toward Community Support Grants
- 3. On March 24, 2022, Commissioners voted to create a separate Ad-Hoc Committee, to plan and implement the Community Support Grants
