SENATE BILL 1205 REVIEW

State Mandated Fire Inspections

- Local fire departments are required to perform annual inspections of all public and private schools, hotels, motels, lodging houses, apartment and condominium buildings under California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3
- The bill also requires the administering authority to formally acknowledge receipt of the compliance report in a resolution
