BID DESCRIPTION: The project entails maintenance improvements within eight residential neighborhoods and one arterial street, Alessandro Boulevard from Mission Grove Parkway to Communications Center Drive, installation of wrought iron fence near Auto Center Dr, installation of new sidewalk on Mountain View Avenue, and the relocation of a storm drain inlet at the intersection of Jefferson Street and Arlington Avenue. The project generally includes but is not limited to asphalt grinding; application of asphalt-rubber aggregate membrane (ARAM); resurfacing asphalt pavements; repairing concrete sidewalks, driveways, pedestrian ramps, curb and gutters, and cross gutters; installation of new bus pads; adjustment of utility meter boxes, valve covers and manholes; slurry seal preservation installation of streetlight and traffic signal conduit; replacement of traffic striping; and traffic signal and signage enhancements.
