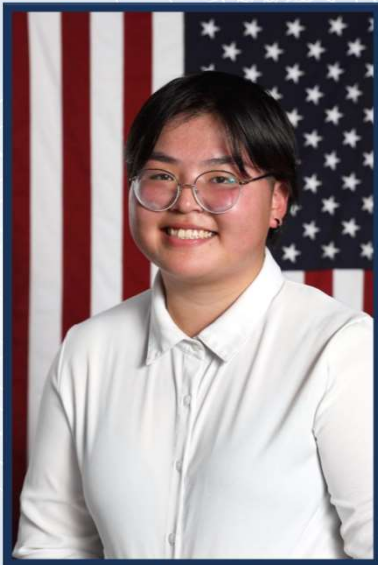

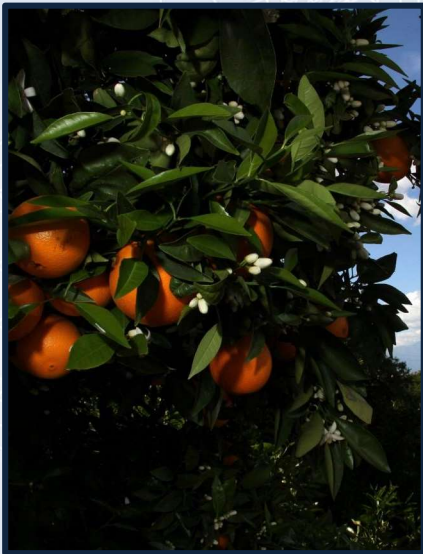

## Lauryn Singh

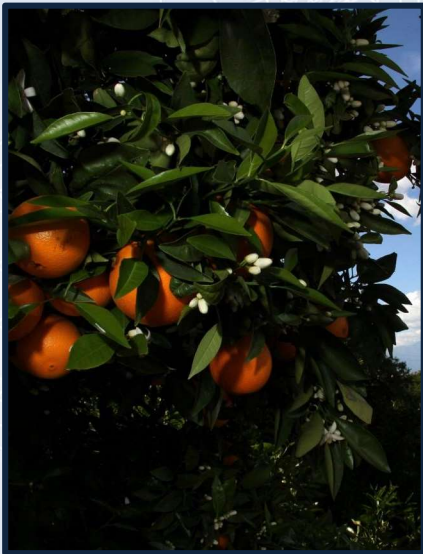
- Junior at Arlington High School
