ISSUE:

Record the absence of Commissioner Binford from the January 30, and April 17, 2023, regular meeting as excused.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Board/Commission Attendance Policy Resolution No. 23976, Board Members shall make every effort to notify the Chairperson or his/her designee no later than 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. A member's inability to provide 24 hours advance notice shall not preclude the board/commission from exercising its discretion to excuse said absence as outlined in Section 805 of the City Charter.

Pursuant to City Charter Section 805, if a member of a board or commission is absent from three consecutive regular meetings, unless by permission of the board or commission expressed in its official minutes, the City Council can declare the office vacant.

DISCUSSION:

Staff received advanced notification from Commissioner Binford regarding absence from the January 30, and April 17, 2023, regularly scheduled meeting.
