- Seven playground replacements
- 13 playground rubber surfacing replacements
- Renovation of parking lots at seven parks
- HVAC repair and replacements at ten facilities
- Flooring at three facilities

Some of these improvements may be further deferred because the funding will likely not cover the estimated costs.
