

#### Notable dates so far:

- Historic Register, 1977
- National History Landmark, 1990
- House donated to City, 2003
- Historic structures report, 2007
- Mark Rawitsch publishes The House on Lemon Street, 2012
- Robinson House acquired, 2014
- "Save America's Treasures" grant awarded, 2020
- \$7 million state allocation, 2021
