



Overview


This presentation will cover the final map chosen at the last Reshape Riverside public hearing conducted on March 28, 2023, and two additional maps requested by the City Council:

- Draft A2.2








Required Redistricting Criteria

FAIR MAPS Act Criteria:

- Relatively equal size people, not citizens
- Contiguous districts should not hop/jump
- Maintain "communities of interest"
- Easily identifiable and understandable lines, following city, natural, and man-made boundaries
- Keep districts compact appearance/function

The Voting Rights Act: *The*

Gingle's Test

- The minority group is geographically concentrated to make up a majority in a district.
- The minority group is politically cohesive, "bloc voting."
- The white majority usually votes against the minority-preferred candidates.
- If all prongs are met, the minority group has less opportunity to elect their candidates of choice.




<u>Draft A2.2: Eastside Neighborhood</u> <u>and Presidential Park COI</u>


- Captures COI testimony from the public
- Captures COI testimony from CM Cervantes and CM Conder
- 21 neighborhoods kept whole
 - This includes Grand, Presidential Park and Arlington South which had minor splits due to census blocks not overlapping with neighborhood lines
 - 6 neighborhoods split













Next Steps

Two directions

Direction #1: Conduct a Public Hearing on the Reshape Riverside Redistricting process and criteria for establishing new ward boundaries.

- Consider Community of Interest Testimony submitted by community members; AND
- Adopt an Ordinance establishing new ward boundaries as directed by City Council on March 28, 2023

Direction #2: Consider Draft Map A2.2 and B1.2 for final selection of establishing the new ward boundaries; and

- Direct the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance establishing the Ward Boundaries Plan; OR
- Provide further direction as the City Council deems appropriate for implementing the City's Reshape Riverside Redistricting Plan.
