



- 6. Participate in City-hosted events: Truckapalooza & Insect Fair








#### CHINA NATIONAL SWORD POLICY



- China no longer accepts recycled goods
- Prior to China's ban, the City made money on recycling
- In FY 22/23, the City paid \$2.3M to recycle
- Recycling is mandatory in California

#### THE WHY

#### **CALIFORNIA SENATE BILL 1383 MANDATES**

- Through Senate Bill 1383, California is the only State to require:
  - a) Organics recycling for all waste
  - b) Edible food recovery programs
  - c) Food waste diversion programs
- FY22/23 \$2.9 Million in commingled organics costs
- Additional staffing and software costs



"These new <u>SB 1383 Regulations are the most far-reaching solid waste management changes in decades</u> and CalRecycle has estimated implementation will cost \$20 to \$40 billion over the next decade."

## Tequesquite Landfill maintenance & reporting:

- \$1.2M gas collection system and flare
- SC-AQMD Compliance

#### California Air Resources Board Advanced Clean Fleet Regulation:

- 50% of new vehicles must be ZEV by Jan 2024
- 100% of new vehicles must be ZEV by 2027

**3,000-3,500 homes delayed** per day





Over 50% of fleet is beyond its useful life

If one driver is out, over 1,000 homes may be delayed





### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 1. Receive a report on proposed changes to residential trash service rates; and
- 2.Direct staff to prepare all documents necessary for public noticing and set a public hearing for recommended residential solid waste rate increases beginning November 1, 2023 through June 30, 2028, on a date at least 45 days after mailing said notice in accordance with Proposition 218.
