CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Per the City's adopted Multi-year Capital Planning Fiscal Policy, to qualify as a capital project, the asset or improvement should have:

- a) monetary value (cost) of at least \$20,000; and
- b) useful life of at least 10 years;

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Per the policy, projects are prioritized using the following factors:

- 1. Risk to Health, Safety and Environment;
- 2. Regulatory or Mandated Requirements;
- 3. Asset Condition, Annual Recurring Costs and Asset Longevity;
- 4. Community Investment and Economic Prosperity;
- 5. Level and Quality of Service;
- 6. Sustainability and Conservation;
- 7. Funding Availability;
- 8. Project Readiness; and
- 9. Multiple Category Benefit and Bundling Opportunities.
