- Concrete pathways
- Solar irrigation controller and general irrigation system improvements

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Award Bid No. 8073 to California Landscape & Design, Inc., of Upland, California, in the amount of \$2,263,000 for the installation of the Tim Strack Park Development Project;
- 2. Authorize 10% change order authority in an amount up to \$226,300 and \$179,913.35 for plan check, permits, inspections and administrative fees, for a project amount not-to-exceed \$2,669,213.35;
- 3. Authorize a budget transfer of \$400,000 of previously allocated ARPA funds from the City-wide Park Improvements Fairmount Park Golf Course Fence project account to the Tim Strack Park Development project account; and
- Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a Construction Agreement with California Landscape & Design, Inc., of Upland, California, including making minor and nonsubstantive changes.
