Street Maintenance Improvements

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BACKGROUND

1. On April 28, 2017, the California Governor signed Senate Bill-1 (SB-1), known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation and critical safety needs.
2. SB-1 increases gas taxes and vehicle registration fees and provides for inflation adjustments to fund these needs.



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BACKGROUND

3. The California State Controller's Office deposits various portions of these revenues into the State's Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA). A percentage of the RMRA funds are apportioned to eligible cities and counties as part the SB-1 Local Street and Roads Program (LSRP).
4. On September 19, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 24039 to approve the FY2023-24 Project List to be completed utilizing the projected FY2023-24 SB-1 revenue.



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BACKGROUND

5. The Public Works Department utilizes a Pavement Management Program and receives service requests from residents to plan various maintenance improvements throughout the City.
6. Every fiscal year, the Public Works Department budgets a portion of State Gas Tax, County Measure A, and Measure Z revenues for street rehabilitation of City arterial and minor streets. This project will rehabilitate marginal, poor, and very poor roads.



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CURRENT PROJECT (BID 8047)

1. Resurface 2.2 miles of arterial street maintenance on
 - MLK Blvd from Kansas Ave to Chicago Ave
 - Mission Grove Pkwy from Trautwein Rd to Alessandro Blvd.
 - Tyler St from Jurupa Ave to Verona St
 - Jurupa Ave from Tyler Ave to Crest Ave
2. Resurface 1.0 mile of major collector Jackson Street from Magnolia Ave to Lincoln Ave
3. Resurface 1.4 miles of minor streets, including streets at the Riverside Auto Center.



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CURRENT PROJECT (BID 8047)

4. Reconstruct 0.2 miles of asphalt street section on northbound Sycamore Canyon Blvd from Core Apartments to the I-215/SR-60 freeway off ramp.
5. Construct new landscaped medians on Jurupa Ave between Idyllwild Ln and Crest Ave.
6. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and pedestrian ramps throughout maintenance locations.
7. Install signing and striping throughout as required.

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PRIOR-YEAR PROJECT (BID 7996)

1. Bid 7996 has already been awarded and is in the construction phase
2. Because non-SB-1 funds were allocated to Bid 7996 out of necessity, and because additional SB-1 funds are now available, staff are suggesting a supplemental appropriation of \$439,603.41 for Bid 7996 from the available Gas Tax/RMRA-2032 Fund Balance to the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 SB-1 Street Maintenance project expenditure account.

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RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 8047 for FY 2023/2024 SB-1 Street Maintenance Improvements to All American Asphalt of Corona, California, in the amount of \$6,706,022.50;
2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the construction contract with All American Asphalt, including making minor non-substantial changes; and



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RECOMMENDATIONS

3. With at least five affirmative votes, authorize the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, to record a supplemental appropriation in the Gas Tax Fund, in the amount \$1,592,481.96 from available fund balance to the RMRA Rehabilitation and Traffic Improvement Project accounts.



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
