SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR SENIORS AND RESIDENTS WITH

DISABILITIES

ISSUE:

The issue for Commission on Disabilities consideration is to receive a report on the transportation services provided for seniors and residents with disabilities by the Special Transportation Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Commission on Disabilities receive this report.

BACKGROUND:

Special low-cost transportation is available to seniors 60 years of age or older, and to residents with disabilities. The cost for this service is \$2 per one-way trip. Space is reserved on a first-come, first-served basis and reservations can be made up to one week in advance by contacting the Special Transportation Division at (951) 687-8080. These transportation services are advertised in the Parks & Recreation Activity Guide, on the City's website, in various senior brochures/programs, at all senior centers and at presentations given at senior living facilities located throughout the City. The Manager of the Special Transportation Division will present information about the services currently available to the City's senior and disabled community.
