A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE CERTAIN CAPITAL EXPENDITURES RELATING TO THE MIGRATION OF THE RIVERSIDE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PUBLIC RADIO SYSTEM TO THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY ENTERPRISE COMMUNICATION SYSTEM ("PSEC") PROJECT FROM ITS PROCEEDS OF DEBT TO BE ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 1.150-2 OF TITLE 26 OF THE U.S. CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside ("City") desires and intends to undertake the purchase of certain services and equipment as part of its migration of the Riverside Police Department's public radio system to the Riverside County Public Safety Enterprise Communication System ("PSEC") Project ("Project") which will include use of the PSEC system ("Services") and equipment related to the radio communication system ("Equipment"); and

WHEREAS, some or all of the Project costs, in the approximate amount of Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00), will need to be advanced by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to issue debt in the form of capital lease financing, in an amount up to Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) to finance a portion or all of the Project on a permanent basis ("Debt"); and

WHEREAS, the City expects that the maximum principal amount of the Debt which will be issued to pay for the Project and the related costs of issuance of the Debt will be in an amount not to exceed Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000); and

WHEREAS, the City reasonably intends to reimburse the City for the amounts advanced for the Project from proceeds of the Debt; and

WHEREAS, at the time of the reimbursement, the City will evidence the reimbursement in a writing which identifies the allocation of the proceeds of the Debt to the City for the purpose of reimbursing the City for capital expenditures made prior to the issuance of the Debt; and

WHEREAS, the City expects to make the reimbursement allocation no later than eighteen (18) months after the later of (i) the date on which the earliest original expenditure is paid, or (ii) the date the Project is placed in service (or abandoned), but in no event later than three (3) years after the date on which the earliest original expenditure is paid; and

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WHEREAS, the City will not, within one (1) year of the reimbursement allocation, use the proceeds of the Debt received in the reimbursement allocation in a manner that will result in the creation of replacement proceeds of the Debt or another issue (e.g., the City will not pledge or use the proceeds received for the payment of the debt service on the Debt of another issue, except that the proceeds of the Debt can be deposited in a bona fide debt service fund); and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is intended to be a "declaration of official intent" in accordance with Title 26 of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 1.150-2 ("Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that in accordance with Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2, the City hereby states its declaration of its intention to issue the Debt in a maximum principal amount of not to exceed Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000) the proceeds of which will be used to pay the costs of the Project, and which will include reimbursement to the City for certain capital expenditures made for the Project prior to issuance of the Debt, including the purchase of the Equipment.
