Resolution No. 22461 effective on October 9, 2012, adopted a Code of Ethics and Conduct for elected officials and members of appointed boards, commissions, and committees. The resolution requires that annually the Mayor, City Manager, City Attorney, and the Chairs of all Boards and Commissions shall meet with the City Council Governmental Affairs Committee to assess the effectiveness of the Ethics Code and its application. The 2014 review did not result in any amendments to the resolution.

This matter will be heard by the Governmental Affairs Committee at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 2, 2015, in the Art Pick Council Chamber.
