The issue before the Board of Library Trustees is an update on the 2015 Leadership Riverside Class's Box Art Project.

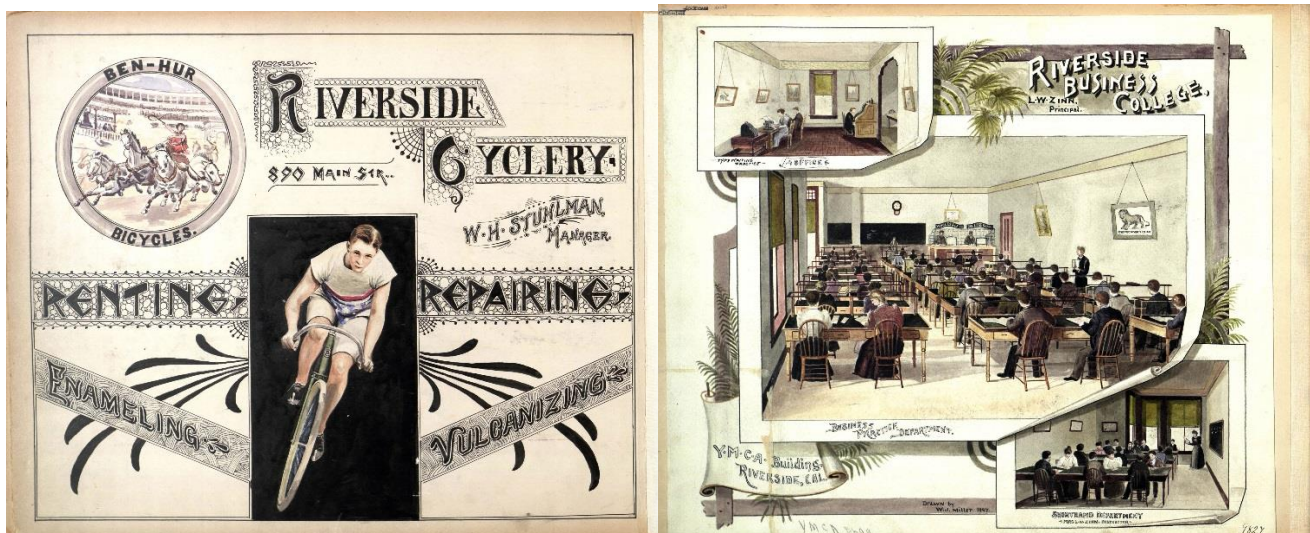
RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Library Trustees receive this report.

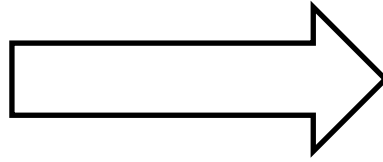
BACKGROUND:

The Leadership Riverside Class of 2015 has raised money to provide artwork to wrap several Riverside Public Utility electrical boxes in the downtown area with historic imagery from the Riverside Public Library's Local History Collection. Library staff will assist the project's graphic designer in the selection and access of images for the boxes. The boxes are sponsored with outside funding and utility staff has been asked for technical assistance to assure safety, and electrical standards are being followed. The Class has created a template for the project to be continued city-wide by other groups and will also engage the community to use the boxes for educational purposes about Riverside History.
