SUBJECT: DESIGNATION OF VOTING DELEGATE FOR LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES 2015 ANNUAL CONFERENCE

## **ISSUE**

The League of California Cities 2015 Annual Conference is scheduled for September 30 through October 2, 2015, and a voting delegate and alternate may be designated to represent the City at the annual business meeting on Friday, October 2, 2015.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

That the City Council designate Councilmember Davis as the voting delegate and Mayor Bailey as alternate for the business meeting of the 2015 League of California Cities annual conference.

## **BACKGROUND**

The League of California Cities (League) holds an annual conference and business meeting to take action on conference resolutions that guide cities and the League in efforts to improve the quality, responsiveness and vitality of local government in California. The City of Riverside has the opportunity to appoint a voting delegate and alternate to represent Riverside at the annual business meeting on Friday, October 2, 2015, in San Jose.

Mayor Bailey and Councilmember Davis concur with these appointments.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The conference travel and meeting expenses are included in the City Council's adopted budget. There is no additional funding needed to designate a voting representative or to perform the duties.
