### BACKGROUND:

In 2011, the American College of Sports Medicine's American Fitness Index ranking Riverside Metropolitan Area 36<sup>th</sup> out of the 50 largest metropolitan areas, and the community's desire to encourage healthier lifestyles, the Riverside City Council voted to form the Fit, Fresh, & Fun Forum in July 2011.
