BACKGROUND

- 1. City Council approved a five year Sewer Services Rates – May 13, 2014.
- 2. February 2014 Capital Improvement Program and Rate Study.
- 3. Effective July 2014 and is effective through June 30, 2019.
- 4. Annual 8.5% increase in monthly services charges.



BACKGROUND

- Annual increase for capacity charges is equal to the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Increase (20-city average).
- 2. City Council directed staff to annually review the rates and report back to the City Council.
- On September 9, 2015 Finance
 Committee recommended to City
 Council to receive and file report.

ANALYSIS

Rates are meeting the operating and capital needs for the Sewer Fund.

- 1. Actual Revenues \$51.2 Million
- 2. Above estimate by \$0.6 Million ~ 1.0%
- 3. Actual Expenditures \$47.7 Million
- 4. Below estimate by \$2.9 Million ~ (5.7%)



ANALYSIS

Expenditures:

- 1. Recruiting for 17 staff vacancies.
- 2. All of the positions are necessary for optimal, long-term operation.
- 3. Maint. Projects reduced or deferred.
- 4. Debt service ~ \$19 Million
- 5. New odor control and membrane bioreactor systems Additional cost expected.

ANALYSIS

- 1. Ending working capital balance at June 30, 2015 estimated at \$46.5 Million
- 2. Increase of approximately \$4.4 Million from the June 30, 2014.
- 3. Currently developing a reserve policy



RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council receive and file the Fiscal Year 2014-15 annual review of the Sewer Services Rates.
