SUBJECT: NINTH STREET – REVISION OF 20-MINUTE PARKING ZONE

ISSUE:

The issue for Transportation Board consideration is revision of the boundaries of the existing 20-Minute Parking Zone on the south side of Ninth Street east of Main Street.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve revision of the boundaries of the existing “20-Minute Parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday, except holidays” Zone on Ninth Street from “south side from Main Street encompassing the first four parking stalls easterly thereof” to “south side from Main Street encompassing the second and third parking stalls easterly thereof.”

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department is installing on-street disabled/ADA parking stalls within existing diagonal parking stalls in the core Downtown Area. A van accessible disabled/ADA parking stall is scheduled to be installed on the south side of Ninth Street east of Main Street which would impact two (2) 20-Minute Parking spaces to install a disabled/ADA parking stall and aisle. The two easterly 20-Minute Parking stalls will remain in place.

A revision of the zone boundaries is necessary to accurately reflect the remaining 20-Minute Parking Zone in the Master Parking Schedule.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of sign and paint installation is nominal. Funding is available in the existing Public Works Department budget.
